DIRECTIONS FOR THE NOMINEE

1. You are instructed by MESA to complete this form and email it to scott.palmer@tkelevator.com on or before May 1, 2025. All information supplied by you is for use by the Scholarship Selection Committee of MESA and will be treated as confidential.
2. Be sure that you have filed an application for admission to the vocational school, junior college, or four-year accredited college(s)/university(s) of your choice, it is the applicant's responsibility to arrange for and take the College Entrance Examination Boards Scholastic Aptitude Test, ACT and/or other appropriate entrance examinations which may be required by each institution which you seek admission. It is the nominee's responsibility to make all arrangements for college admission.
3. A one-time scholarship in the amount of \$2,000 will be awarded to two winning nominees selected by the Committee based on their high school record of achievement, grades and statement.
4. Please secure and attach the following information with your application:
 - Your current high school academic transcript and grades.
 - Standardized test scores (i.e. SAT/ACT Scores) optional
 - A copy of the Common Application and/or a completed and filed admission application to the vocation school, junior college, or four-year accredited college(s) or university(s) of your choice.
 - Attach letters of recommendation (maximum of three) supporting the nominee as a candidate for a scholarship.
 - A recent black & white or color glossy photograph.

2. A one-time \$2,000 Scholarship will be awarded to two high school seniors: Family members of an MESA member who has been **in good standing for at least this year and immediate previous year. (2024 & 2025)**

 - A. MESA NOMINATION FORM AND SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM
 - B. COMMON APPLICATION or COLLEGE APPLICATION
 - C. HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT
 - D. STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES (SAT/ACT/Etc.)
 - E. LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION-MAXIMUM OF THREE (3)
 - F. RECENT PHOTOGRAPH - BLACK & WHITE OR COLOR
4. The Section Committee will consider only those fully completed nominations received by **May 1, 2025**.
5. The Scholarship Selection Committee will be comprised of a chairperson appointed by the President, and two volunteer Members.
6. Individual members are permitted to submit one (1) application per year. Corporate members are permitted to submit a maximum of four (4) applications per year per corporation. No employee of a corporate member may submit more than one (1) application per year. Corporate applications will be accepted on an as received basis.
7. A MESA Officer will inform the recipients of their selection in an award letter containing the terms and requirements that scholarship recipients must fulfill.
8. Money will be directly payable to recipient.
9. To use the Scholarship, recipients may attend any technical training school, any junior college, or a four-year accredited college or university of their choice. In order to receive the G. Gahr Finney Memorial Scholarship, the recipient must attend the fall term of the college selected and take a full-course load leading toward graduation.
10. The recipient of the G. Gahr Finney Memorial Scholarship may be asked to accept the award in person at one of our monthly meetings.
